Dear Parents,

PE Kit List

As the new school year approaches, we know you will be preparing for children's new year of school, so we are sending our PE kit requirements. If you are planning on piercing your child's ears, please use the 6 weeks holiday as the time to do this and allow time to heal, as children are not permitted to wear earrings in PE and will need to remove these to take part in PE.

Children are expected to wear;

- Shorts (indoor or summer kit) or tracksuit bottoms (outdoor or winter kit) and a plain, white t-shirt
- Pumps or trainers for all outdoor PE and indoor games. Children will be barefoot during gymnastics and dance activities including lessons that require any apparatus unless the child has a verrucae where a plaster to cover must be provided by the parent. **Socks must not be worn on their own at any time in PE.**
- **Jewellery is to be removed at home prior to PE (bracelets, earrings etc). If it is not removed children will not be able to take part in PE.**
- Earrings must be removed at home prior to PE on the morning of PE. Staff will not be removing or covering earrings. Children will not take part in PE.
- No zips or hoodies to be worn for indoor activities to ensure children do not over heat.
- For lessons that do not require leaving the classroom e.g. CyberCoach, a change of footwear and removal of jumper is adequate for this activity within the classroom.
- Any extra-curricular sports activities require PE kit and children will need to ensure their kit is in school on these days and PE days or they will not be able to take part.

As you can see there are no changes to the kit required to undertake PE in lessons but it is requirement of all children to have a PE kit separate to their school uniform to take part in lessons.

If children are not provided with adequate PE kit, parents will be informed and children will need to take part in evaluative roles in the PE lesson whereby they take part in the listening and the learning but do not undertake the physical activity to ensure their safety and others around them.

If you are unable to provide PE kit for your child school can provide the basics for a small charge payable to the school office. The request letter is attached and we are able to ensure your child has a PE kit ready for September.
