Dear Parents,

Year 1 Forest Habitats Exploring at Cannock Chase – Wednesday 1st March 2017.

For our Marvellous Middle during this topic Year 1 would like to visit Cannock Chase to take part in a ranger lead activity day at Cannock Chase exploring Forest Habitats on **Wednesday 1st March 2017**. Children will meet the ranger upon arrival, followed by a morning in the forest collecting leaves, learning basic tree ID and exploring the forest environment. The children will learn about the forest habitat through games and activities, such as bug hunts and seasonal colour games.

The trip cost is **£14.50 per child** and this includes our coach travel to and from Cannock Chase and the cost of the ranger lead experience for each child. We are happy for this to be paid in instalments of £2 per week up until it is paid in full with a deposit of £5. Please indicate on your reply slip if this is your preferred payment method. If you wish to pay in full please include the full payment of £14.50 with the consent form attached in a clearly labelled envelope. All money needs to be received by no later than Friday 17th February 2017.

The children will need to wear weather appropriate clothing as the day will be spent outside. Children must be sent in a coat and wellies are advised due to the nature of the activities we will be undertaking. Spending money is not required.

Children will need a packed lunch for the trip and we ask for you to indicate below whether you would like a packed lunch to be provided by school or whether you will provide one. All children in Year 2 are entitled to a free school meal, if you would like one provided. Children will have their lunch during the day in the facilities provided by the rangers at Cannock Chase.
